- reach for: to try to get with one's hand


### **Key Expressions**

- = It's no problem.




John and Carlos meet by the vending machine.

  - = Do you need me to do anything?




Julia shows her bag to Mary.

They blow up some balloons.




Julia ties some string to a balloon.

### Wrapping a Gift


### Words and Phrases to Learn

  - = Who gave this present?




Peter arrives at the party.
